VMAP Project ECHO Early Childhood **SOCKs: Systems of Care for Kids** takes an “all teach, all learn” approach to understanding when, how, and where to refer families of young children. Community-based subject matter experts will be paired with an interdisciplinary faculty team to provide practical and actionable infant and toddler connections for supportive pediatric primary care. Cohort members may participate in an optional QI Project to help enhance screening and referral for social determinants of health supports.

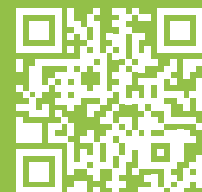
